- 2.2. why the costs of this application should not be costs in the administration of the respondent's insolvent estate;
3. Service of this Order is to be effected:
 - 3.1. by service on the respondent at 11A Main Road, Sea Point, Cape Town, Western Cape;
 - 3.2. by service on the South African Revenue Service at 22 Hans Strijdom Avenue, Cape Town, Western Cape;
 - 3.3. by service on the employees of the respondent, if any;
 - 3.4. by service on every registered trade union representing the employees of the respondent, if any; and
4. The Sheriff shall attach all movable property of the insolvent estate and shall immediately after effecting the attachment, report to the Master in writing that the attachment has been effected and shall submit with such report a copy of the inventory in terms of section 19(1) of the Insolvency Act No 24 of 1936.
