on behalf of Applicant;

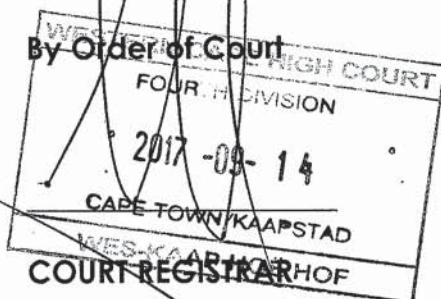
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
