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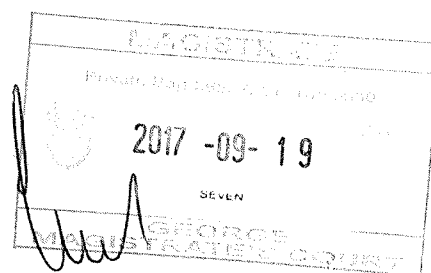
**ORDER**

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**After hearing representation for the applicant, the following order is granted:**

1. Wankekile Transport CC is provisionally liquidated.
2. A *rule nisi* is issued calling upon all interested parties to give reasons, if any, on **3 October 2017** at 10h00, as to why:
  - 2.1 Wankekile Transport CC should not be finally liquidated;
  - and
  - 2.2 The costs of this application, on a scale as between attorney and client, should not be costs in the liquidation of Wankekile Transport CC.
3. In terms of the provisions of Section 19 of the Insolvency Act:

- 3.1 The Registrar/Clerk shall transmit a copy of the winding-up order to the Sheriff of George.
- 3.2 The Sheriff shall attach all property which appears to belong to Wankelekile Transport CC and transmit to the Master an inventory of all property attached by him or her in terms of Section 19 of the Insolvency Act 24 of 1936.
4. Service and publication of the Provisional Sinding-Up Order shall be effected as follows:
- 4.1 Be served on the Applicant at its registered address by the Sheriff or his deputy, as the case may be;
- 4.2 Be served on the Receiver of Revenue by the Sheriff or his deputy.
- 4.3 On all known creditors of the Applicant with claims of more than R20 000.00 by prepaid registered post; and
- 4.4 By publication in one edition each of the "George Herald" and "Die Burger" newspaper.



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BY ORDER OF COURT
