**IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That the applicant is hereby placed under provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the High Court;
2. That a rule *Nisi* hereby issues calling upon all interested parties to show cause, if any, on **Thursday, 2 November 2017 at 10h00** to this court why a

final order should not be granted and why the costs of the application should not be costs in the liquidation;

3. That this order:

- 3.1 Be served on the applicant's remaining employee at the applicant's principal place of business at Unit 14 SACS Centre, Saxenburg Park, Muscat Road, Blackheath, by the Sheriff by attaching a copy thereof to the notice board or front door to which the employees have access;
- 3.2 Be served on all known creditors of the applicant with claims exceeding the amount of R25 000.00 by way of prepaid registered post;
- 3.3 Be served on the South African Revenue Service;
- 3.4 Be published in one edition each of the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers.
