Having perused the papers filed of record and having heard counsel on behalf of the applicant;


IT IS ORDERED:

- 3.2 On all known creditors of the respondent with claims exceeding the amount of R25 000.00 by way of registered post;
- 3.3 On the South African Revenue Service:
- On the employees of the respondent by affixing a copy thereof on the notice board of the employees at the principal place of business of the respondent or failing a notice board then on the front door.
- 3.5 Be published in one edition each of the "CAPE TIMES" and "DIE BURGER" newspapers.
- 4. The Registrar shall transmit a copy of this order to the Sheriff of the province in which the registered office of the respondent is situate and to the Sheriff of every province in which it appears that the respondent owns business.

5. The Sheriff shall attach all property which appears to belong to the respondent and transmit to the Master an inventory of all property attached by him or her in terms of section 19 of the Insolvency Act 24 of 1936.
