Applicant, it is hereby Ordered that:


That the Respondent be placed under provisional order of winding up in the hands of the Master of the abovenamed Court;

 - 2.1. The Respondent should not be finally liquidated; and
 - 2.2. The costs of this application on a scale as between attorney and client, should not be costs in the liquidation of the Respondent.

 of 1936, read with section 339 of the Companies Act 61 of 1973:
