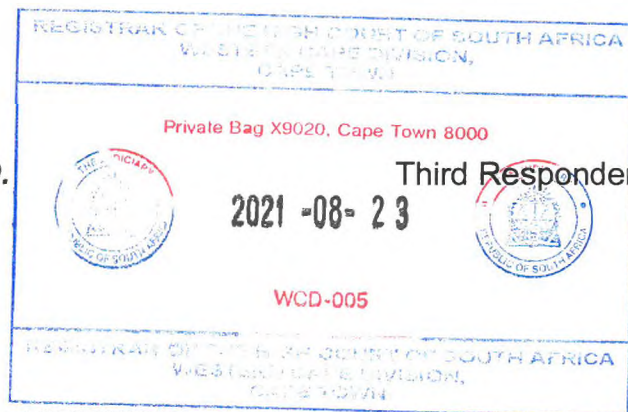

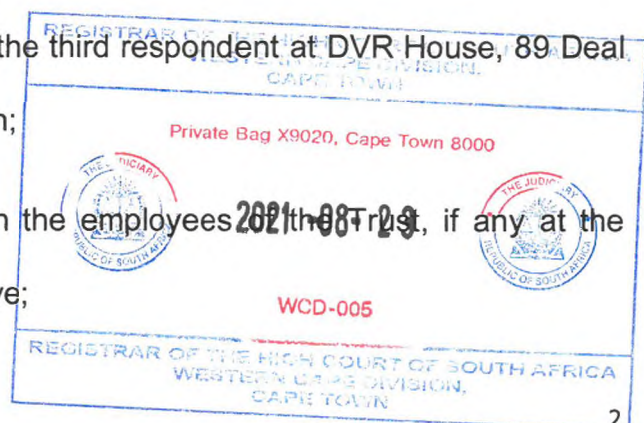

Having read the papers filed of record and having heard counsel on behalf of the applicant, it is hereby ordered that:

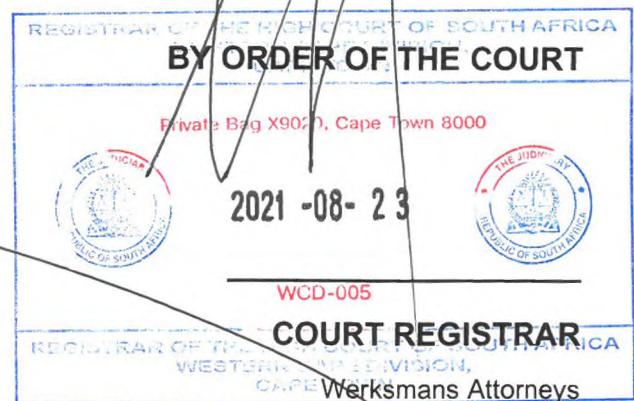
1. The Silcor Trading Trust (IT856/2010) ("the Trust") is placed under provisional sequestration in the hands of the Master of the above Court;

2. A rule *nisi* is issued calling upon all interested parties to give reasons, if any, on **THURSDAY, 07 OCTOBER 2021** as to why:
 - 2.1. A final order of sequestration should not be granted; and
 - 2.2. The costs of this application, on an attorney-client scale, should not be costs in the sequestration;

3. Service of this order be effected:
 - 3.1. By the Sheriff, or his deputy, on the first to third respondents at 32 Sagittarius Lane, Croydon Vineyard Estate, Somerset West;
 - 3.2. By the Sheriff, or his deputy, on the second respondent at 16 Juniper Road, Faerie Knowe, Fish Hoek, Western Cape;
 - 3.3. By the Sheriff, or his deputy, on the third respondent at DVR House, 89 Deal Road, Dan Pienaar, Bloemfontein;
 - 3.4. By the Sheriff, or his deputy, on the employees ~~2021-08-29~~, if any at the addresses set out in 3.1-3.3 above;



- 3.5. By the Sheriff, or his deputy, on any registered trade union representing any employees of the Trust, if any, at the addresses set out in 3.1-3.3 above;
- 3.6. On the South African Revenue Service;
- 3.7. On the Master of the High Court; and
- 3.8. By publication in one edition each of the Cape Times and Die Burger;
4. The Registrar shall transmit a copy of the winding-up order to the Sheriff of the province in which the registered office of the Trust is situate and to the Sheriff of every province in which it appears that the Trust owns business for the purposes of attaching all property which appears to belong to the Trust.
5. The sheriff is authorised to attach all property which appears to belong to the Trust and to transmit to the Master an inventory of all property attached by him or her.
