2. The estate of the First Respondent (Dierdre Desmore-Salie) is placed under provisional sequestration.

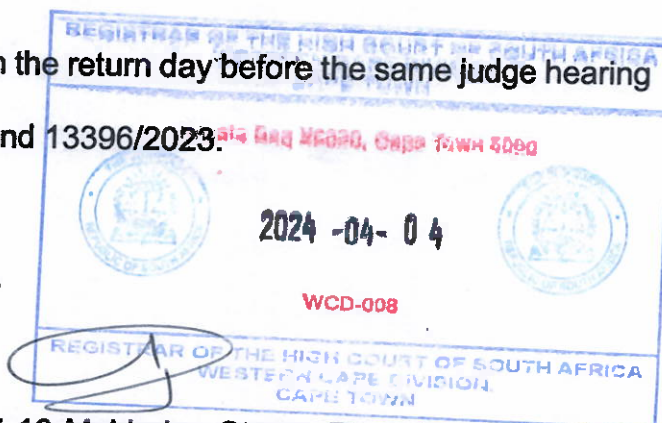
3. A *rule nisi* is issued calling upon Dierdre Desmore-Salie to show cause, if any, to this court, on Monday, 13 May 2024:

3.2. Why the costs of this application, including the costs of two counsel, should not be costs in the sequestration of Dierdre Desmore-Salie's estate.

4. This matter must be enrolled on the return day before the same judge hearing cases 3513/2023, 8355/2023 and 13396/2023.

5.1. Dierdre Desmore-Salie at 16 Meidoring Street, Rouxville, Kuils River, Cape Town, Western Cape;


5.2. Second Respondent (Ebrahim Salie) at 16 Meidoring Street, Rouxville, Kuils River, Cape Town, Western Cape;
